Know that Blue, Green and Purple belong to the cool colour family. Know that sliders and levers are mechanisms. Know the movement of a slider and a lever and demonstrate how one is constructed. 	<p>Unit: Harvest</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> that not everyone in the world enjoys a good harvest. about Christian charities that are helping people who live in poor countries. that some religious followers believe it is good to say thank you to a god for the harvest. that the Jewish festival of harvest is called Sukkot. <p>Giving and Receiving Gifts</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Diwali and Hanukkah are religious festivals People of faith celebrate festivals by giving and receiving gifts. that the wise men visited Jesus after the shepherds. that Christians believe that Jesus is a gift from God.
