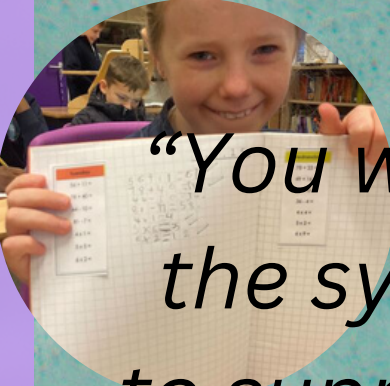


Next academic year, we will review the timings of progress evenings to ensure teacher and parent/carers meetings are longer.





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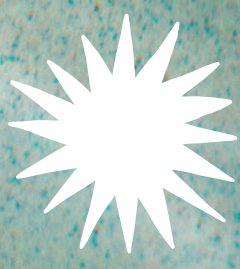


“You would like a clearer idea of the syllabus and topics studied to support and reinforce learning at home.”
